Outdoor Development Day coming up!

On **Saturday 13th October** we are holding our next development day. This is a great opportunity to work as a team with other parents in school and some of the school staff. Our last 2 days have been very successful and we are hoping that this one will be just as great! School will be open **between 9:30am and 2:30pm** for volunteers to come along and help. Even if you can offer 1 hour on the day it will be greatly appreciated... Many hands make light work!!!

Throughout the day we are hoping to achieve some of the following from the next phase of the development:

- ✦ Pond area - Cut back the bushes, trees, nettles and grass. Dig out and line the new pond, lay the edging slabs and fill the pond. Repair the fence post and rehang the correct size gate.
- ✦ Sensory garden - Build the bench that goes between the bamboo plants. Add the gauze to the 'Talking Tubes'. Build the frame for the boat and install it (including drainage).
- ✦ Fencing and walls - Finish painting the fences and paint over the mural.
- ✦ Maths Classroom Bay - Build the seating around the edges. Hang the new wall mounted hose reel.
- ✦ Year 1 Area - Fit anchor bolts in to the shed.

Gardening – Weed and tend to the plants in the sensory garden.
