Dear Parents /Carers

Firstly, this is new, for all of us. There are bound to be worries and anxieties about how to provide for your children in the best way.

We are here to help you as much as possible. That is why you will be receiving the following:

- A daily email from teachers outlining the learning activities for the day. Unless there are unforeseen circumstances, you will receive your email by 8:55 each day. Expect the first email to arrive on Monday 23rd March
- We will give some advice on top tips for learning bearing in mind parents have to juggle all manner of day to day tasks
- A timetable for the week with an explanation for each task and recommended time to spend on each activity
- Exercise books for children to complete the learning tasks. For those children not at school this week we will be arranging for you to either collect them from school if possible or we will deliver them to you.
- A class email address for you to contact your child's class teacher for any queries and to upload photos of learning for the teacher to provide feedback to your child
- Guidelines as to how Tapestry can be used for Reception parents
- A mobile phone contact number for each class so that parents can text the teacher to request a phone call to discuss any issues
