Hello everyone

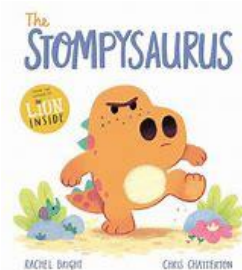
The children have made a fantastic start to the term and are trying really hard with their learning. Well done to our first VIPs! We will find out on Monday who has the award next week.
