# ONLINE SAFETY – WHAT WE DO IN SCHOOL



Curriculum	<ul> <li>In the Autumn term in Years 1 and 2 the first unit of work in computing is all about online safety</li> <li>This is followed up with assemblies in the Spring term linked to Safer Internet Day</li> </ul>
Filtering & web content	<ul> <li>RM Swgfl provides a firewall that blocks and restricts content. This can be managed by the school (in our school this is the headteacher).</li> <li>If we see any inappropriate content being accessed by a member of staff or a child, then this is reported to the headteacher. It is then added to the blocked and restricted content list.</li> <li>Youtube is accessible and unfiltered which supports lesson delivery. Therefore, a child never accesses Youtube unsupervised.</li> <li>When a child is searching via a search engine that is outside of Purple Mash or other educational programs that we subscribe to, they must always be supervised and the adult must always check the content is appropriate (preferably prior to the search commencing).</li> </ul>
Devices	<ul> <li>Children must only use the school's devices such as the Chromebooks and iPads</li> <li>Children must always have been given permission to use a school device</li> <li>Children can take photos and videos but this must only be for a specific educational purpose such as presenting or going on a minibeast hunt etc</li> <li>Staff and volunteers must only use school devices to take photos and videos within school and on visits.</li> <li>Photos and videos must never be transferred onto personal devices or published on social media without direct permission from the headteacher or assistant headteacher (in exceptional circumstances only).</li> </ul>
