### ATTENDANCE FOR THIS SCHOOL YEAR






Whole school to date: 97.8% (national average 95.3%) It is fantastic to see that we are in the top 2% of schools nationally. We hope your child stays healthy and well.



Science – Miss Cheeseman


Personal, Social, Health & Relationships Education (PSHRE) - Mrs Robinson
