ATTENDANCE FOR THIS SCHOOL YEAR



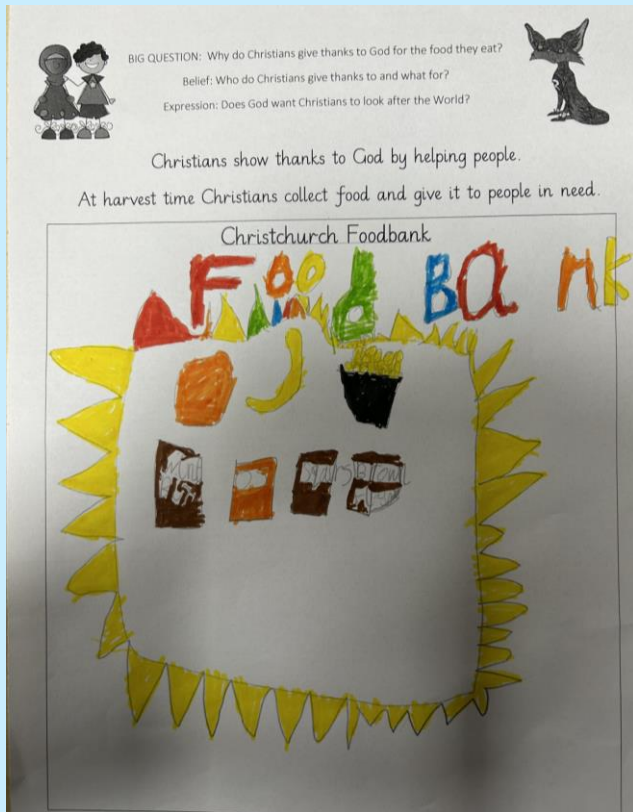
Whole school to date: 97.5% (national average 95.2%)
