## **IMPORTANT - ONLINE SAFETY**



We are having to have a number of conversations with children across the school, particularly in Year 2 about how scared they feel because of something they have watched on YouTube. They often say they are allowed to just go on it unsupervised and this is when they watch inappropriate content that they talk about with their friends and adults in school. Some children say they find it difficult to sleep because of what they have seen. They sometimes also then bring this into their play which can result in other children feeling worried about these characters and what they do onscreen.

Please could you make sure that your child is only accessing online content that is age appropriate. Without filters and supervision, it is very easy for your child to access something they should not be watching with just one tap of the screen. It is worth noting that sometimes children say there are parental controls at home but not when they visit friends and relatives.
